We regret that some of our valued donors and volunteers did not receive the [June 2017 announcement](#) that Recovery Acres Society intended to sell a property purchased as part of the Breaking New Ground capital campaign. We unreservedly apologize to any supporter who did not receive communication from us about the decision to sell and our reasons for making that difficult decision. Our goal at Recovery Acres Society remains to serve men and women who suffer from addiction. In order to do that, we need to make sound financial decisions that ensure our facilities and addiction treatment programs will be there when men and women need them. The unsuccessful BNG project was not viable without government funding. Continuing to amass the expenses of maintaining this commercial property would not have been good stewardship of the funds entrusted to us.

We sincerely thank the donors and volunteers who supported the BNG campaign both financially and through diligent efforts to generate awareness for this project. While the project could not be completed as originally planned, the sale of the land does provide Recovery Acres with potential to improve and expand our treatment programs and facilities. It is our intent to move forward in a way that benefits the people we serve and brings a satisfactory outcome to our valued supporters.
